



## Expressive Arts Therapy Professional Training Program Financial Overview & Policies 2021-2022

**Tuition:** \$5,300 for the 150-hour training. This includes 10 hours per month for a total of 10 months (September 2021-June 2022) of class time. The remaining hours (50) will include home assignments and online participation. *Books, and additional art materials are not included in tuition.*

**Confirmation of acceptance and deposit of \$449.00 is due on August 2nd, 2021.**

- **Payment Plan:** If you choose to pay tuition using the 12-month payment plan, monthly payments must be paid from one account and deducted by automatic transfer from a checking, savings, or credit card account. Eleven monthly installments of \$441.00 are due on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month, starting September 2021 and ending in July 2022.
- **Pay in Full:** If you choose to pay in full and receive the 5% discount, the deposit of \$449 is due by August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021. The remaining tuition of \$ 4,586.00 is due by September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

### **Cancellation and Refund Policy for the Northwest Creative & Expressive Arts Institute (“NWCEAI”) Expressive Arts Therapy Certificate Training Program (“Training Program”)**

- If NWCEAI receives a cancellation at least 30 days before the starting date of the Training Program (August 11<sup>th</sup>) the student will be able to redistribute their tuition to a future offering of the Training Program with payment of a **\$250 processing fee**. No refund of any amount will be offered
- Redistribution of tuition is only applicable towards the Training Program, not towards any NWCEAI workshops, events or open studios.
- Redistribution of tuition must occur within **2 (two) years** of cancellation.
- If NWCEAI receives a cancellation less than 30 days before the starting date of the Training Program, **no redistribution of tuition will be offered. No refund of any amount will be available.**
- The above policies apply to students paying in full or using the 12-month payment plan.

- NWCEAI is not responsible for giving refunds for the Training Program, classes, workshops, or other events dropped or missed due to illness, emergencies, or events beyond our control.
- Cancellations due to illness or events outside the student's control will be considered on an individual basis.
